



## SCHOOL PERFORMANCE (CEC)

As a learning community *Committed to Excellence in Education*, we are continually looking to improve the School District of Waupaca. One source we use to reflect on our strengths and areas for improvement is the School Report Card. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) annually generates a School and District Report Card for every publicly funded school and district in the state. The report cards are intended to help schools and districts utilize performance data to target their improvement efforts so that students are ready for their next educational step – including the next grade level, graduation, college, and careers.

Another way in which we monitor our performance is through the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), reauthorized as the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). As a public school district supported by taxpayer dollars, we are required to share certain data with the state and public. Based on the information shared with the state, members of the public can access a dashboard that serves as the source for accessing Waupaca's data required under ESSA.
